Winter/Spring Session for New Students



Our Winter/Spring Session begins February 20th. This is a short session, running from Saturday, February 20th to Saturday, May 1st, and is much smaller in terms of enrollment than our Main Session, with only five weekly classes offered.

Jazz Classes for various age groups (K through 2nd grade, 3rd through 6th, teens, and adults) are offered in this session, as well as Basic Movement for Preschoolers.

For Winter/Spring 2010, the following class options are available at CDMC:

- Basic Movement for Preschoolers – Saturdays noon to 12:30 PM
- Jazz for Kindergarten through 2nd grade – Saturdays 12:30 to 1:15 PM
- Jazz for 3rd through 6th grade – Saturdays 1:15 to 2:00 PM
- Teen Jazz – Saturdays 2:00 to 2:45 PM
- Adult Jazz – Saturdays 2:45 to 3:30 PM

During Picture Weekend, our dancers will be professionally photographed at the studio in their full recital costumes, both with their group and individually.

Annual Egg Hunt

Our yearly tradition continues with our annual egg hunt on Saturday, April 3rd at 3:00 PM. There's no charge for students whose accounts are up to date. Non-student siblings who wish to participate may do so at an additional cost of \$5 per child. Participants must register at the counter by March 27th (one week prior to the event), to allow time to organize the event and purchase the appropriate number of prizes.

Over 300 candy-filled plastic eggs will be hidden on the studio grounds (weather permitting.) Some of the eggs have pieces of paper with numbers on them – those are very special, because after the egg hunt, the student with number 1 gets to be first to pick a prize from the prize table (stuffed animal, coloring book, hot wheels car, etc.). We continue through the numbers until every child has chosen a prize. (Don't worry – if your child doesn't find an egg with a number in it, we'll make sure he/she gets one. ☺)

Don't be late – it's a mad rush for eggs at 3:00 PM! (We do give the little ones a head start – we line the students up by age, and the youngest get to collect a few eggs before the next age group begins.)
